HALE VILLAGE 5 MILE ROAD RACE EVENT NOTIFICATION

The Hale Village 5 Mile Race which will be held on the morning of Easter Sunday 17th April 2022 with the start time 9:30am.

Course

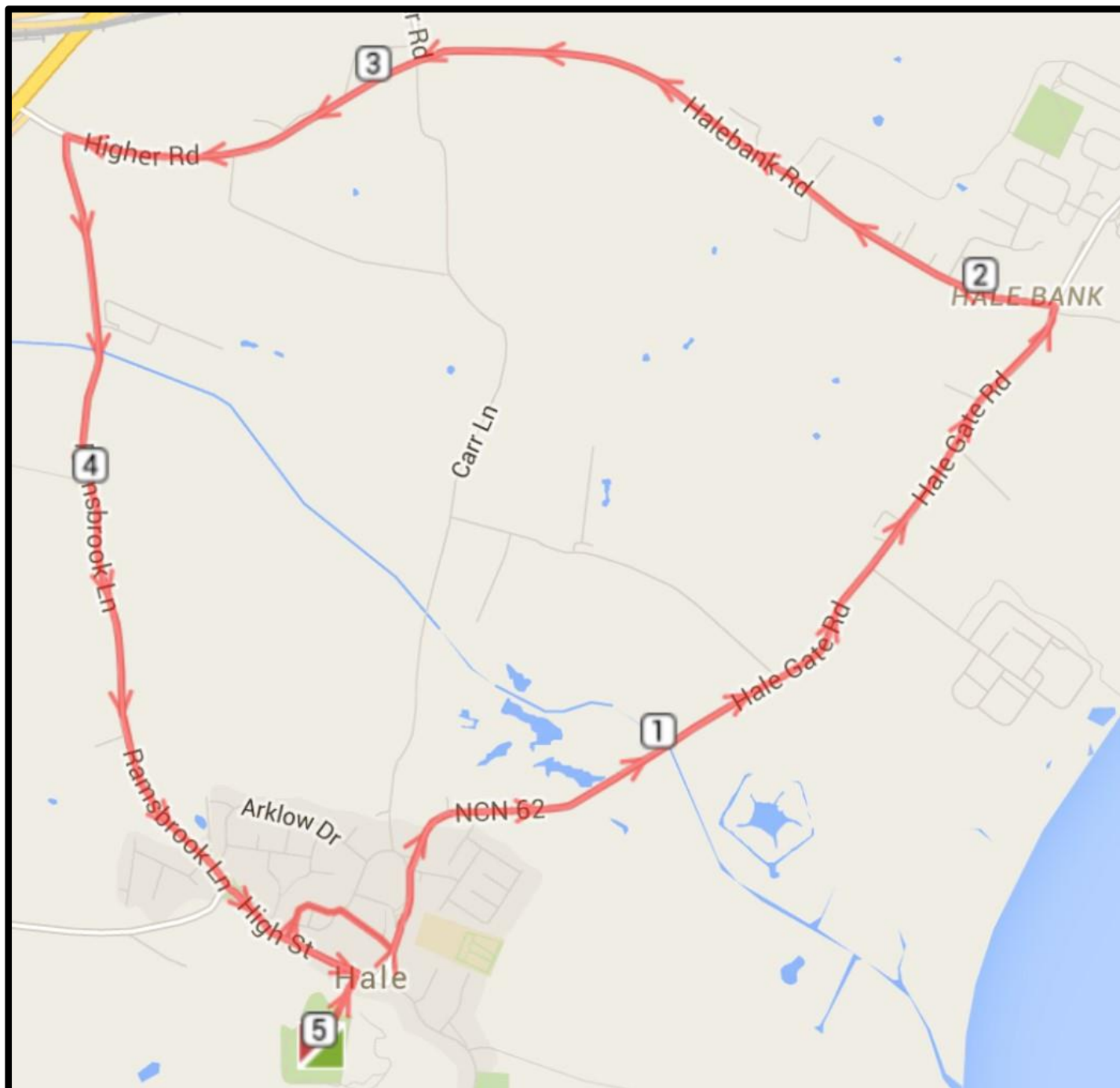
The race is run over one loop on the roads in the surrounding area of Hale Village and Hale Bank. The route is traffic managed and marshalled. The following course map illustrates the route the race will take and is available on the race website at www.intervalraces.co.uk.

The route starts and finishes in Hale Park. The race will exit Hale Park at the start turn left onto High Street then right into Cocklade Lane then through Pepper Street and then left onto NCN 62 and Hale Gate Road. From here the route turns onto Halebank Road, Ramsbrook Lane back onto High Street and finishes in the park. Access to Carr Lane will also be affected during this period for race day parking.

Please be aware therefore on this date some road closures and diversions in place from 8:30am onwards with possible delays. Traffic management will reopen roads as the last runners complete the course. Last runners will be estimated to finish the race 10:15-10:30 with the roads reopening behind them on the course on a rolling basis, ensuring swift access. Access and passage will be provided with as few delays as possible through the traffic management and marshal team. We apologise for any inconvenience.
