



# HALE VILLAGE 5 MILE RACE

## Participant Information

The Hale Village 5 Mile Race will be held on the morning of Sunday April 17th 2022 with the start time 9:30am.

## Registration

The registration centre will be based in the new Hale Village Hall, opposite the entrance to Hale Park where the race starts within Hale Village. The postcode is **L24 4AX**

## Parking

Please note parking will be available on Carr Lane near the race site. To maximise use and reduce delay, access to Carr Lane will only be available on race morning at the Halebank Road end. Postcode **WA8 8PD**.

Those using the road for parking must enter at the Halebank Road end and drive to the Hale Village end as directed by race officials and park appropriately considering other cars. Race marshals will be situated at the Halebank Road entrance and at the Hale Village end to provide assistance.

Upon Exiting Carr Lane on foot head to Hale Park off High Street for the Race Start

## Directions

Hale Village is only 2.5 miles from Liverpool John Lennon Airport. Initial approach via signage for the airport in all directions will bring you to signage leading to Hale Village

For Sat Nav users use the postcode **L24 4AX**

If heading to Carr Lane to park sat nav users should use the postcode **WA8 8PD**

## First Aid

On the day Interval Races will provide first aid cover via Spark Medical. First aiders will be available at the start finish.

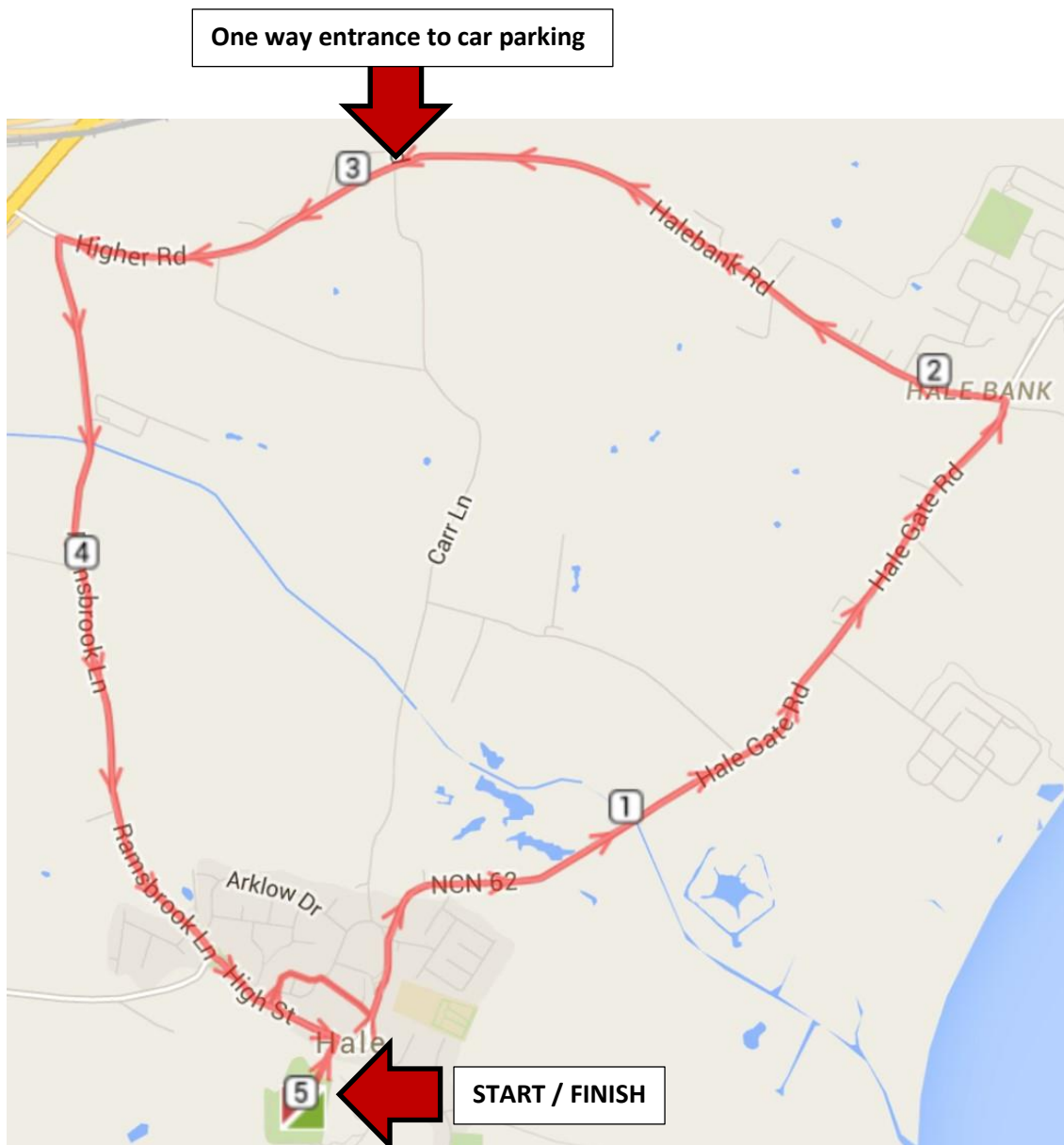
## Prizes

The race is run over one loop on the roads surrounding Hale Village and Halebank. The route is traffic managed and is well marshalled.
